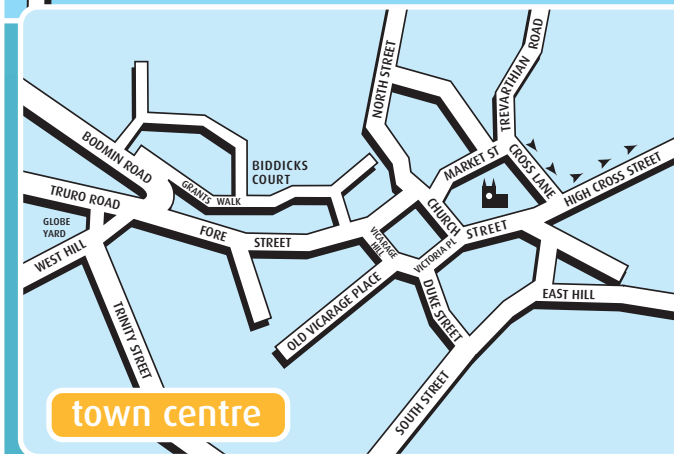


car parks & directions



where to park

- **Car park 1:** Sedgemoor provides best access to Priory Road and Bodmin Road
- **Car park 2:** Priory gives excellent central access to the town centre including Fore Street shops and the ten pin bowling alley
- **Car park 3:** Station car park provides access to the library, police station and, of course, the bus and railway station
- **Car park 4:** West Hill
- **Car park 5:** East Hill
- **Car park 6:** Polkyth (park and ride) and access to the library as well as Polkyth Leisure Centre
